DECLARATON OF DISASTER FOR SOMERVELL COUNTY

Whereas, THE County of Somervell on the 18th of July, 2022 is under imminent threat of severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from:

THE THREAT OF WILDFIRES IN SOMERVELL COUNTY; and

WHEREAS THE COUNTY JUDGE of Somervell County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to prevent fires in Somervell County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF SOMERVELL COUNTY:

WHEREAS the potential for the evacuation of the population of Somervell County,

WHEREAS the necessity to impose extraordinary provisions such as wage, rent and price controls; curfews, blockades and limitation on the usage of utilities or other critical public services; set rules governing the ingress and egress to affected areas; and use the personnel and equipment resources of the County for the protection of life and property in those environs exists,

THEREFORE, by the authority granted to me by the Texas Disaster Act (Government Code Chapter 18 paragraph 418.108) and the Somervell County Emergency Management Plan Section VI, C and as the presiding officer of the County do hereby declare that a state of disaster exists beginning at

4 pm on the 18th day of July 2022 and existing for a period of time not to exceed 7 days.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after issuance, ORDERED THIS THE 18TH DAY JULY 2022.
